Eye Disorders

Red Eye

The red eye is a very common problem and can arise from a **numerous origins**:

- Viral
- Bacterial
- Chlamydial
- Allergic disorders
- Chemical
- Degenerative
- Pigmented lesions
- Non-pigmented lesions

A few **signs and symptoms** can typically be present:

- 1) Oedema/swelling
- 2) Hyperaemia/redness
- 3) Discharge
- 4) Photophobia/light sensitivity
- 5) Foreign body sensation
- 6) Visual changes
- 7) Pain



Chronic Blepharitis

The most common external eye disorder encountered in practice is Blepharoconjunctivitis (chronic blepharitis). It is thought that the causes are staphylococcal and seborrhoea in origin but the exact aetiology is unclear.



Treatments

Medical:

- Topical Sterioids
- Topical Antibiotics
- Topical Steriod-antibiotic combination agents
- Oral antibiotics
- Oral nutritional supplements

Non-Medical:

- Warm Compresses
- Eyelid Scrubs

Hordeolum

Internal Hordeolum / Chalazion often requires incision and curettage.
External Hordeolum / Stye most often requires systemic and topical antibiotics.
Heat compresses for small styes are often helpful.
