Type and Script of RX Lens

Lens Thickness

Worried about the outcome of your lenses? High lens scripts especially for myopia and astigmatism have a greater edge thickness when larger frames are used. For cosmetic reasons - especially lens thickness - choose a smaller frame. A plastic frame also hides the thickness of the lens better than a metal or rimless frame.

Be aware that an excessive curved frame can create difficulty in the fitting process and cause severe discomfort with visual distortion. Please ask one of our friendly staff for advice when you consider using a wrap-around frame. The higher the INDEX of a lens, - the THINNER the lens will be. Aspheric designed lenses also give a better cosmetic appearance on lens thickness than standard lenses.

Adjusting plate height or Surface curvature can dramatically improve the appearance of your lenses. For far sighted patients please take note that the edge of the lens is thinner than the centre.

A rimless frame is NOT the best choice for High PLUS lenses, as the lens can break easily on the thin edges. Rather look at metal or plastic full frames. The larger the frame - the thinner the edge of the lens will be.
